What Kind of Relationship?

It seems sometimes that God is pulling all the strings in our lives without really letting us know what's going on. So the desire I have to understand what He's doing is, in fact, a valid part of the relationship; but it's secondary to the need to trust what He's doing. Trust and understanding are both vital aspects of a real relationship. But in our relationship with God, trust has to take precedence.
